This summer Westney Heights Youth ministry had the privilege of taking a team to Honduras to help support the Casa Hogar children's home ministry. July 4 - 15, 2024.

Through the Fellowship website we learned about FAIR and the Casa Hogar ministry. After being in contact with Rick & Ena Ward, they visited our church and presented the needs and opportunities of serving at Casa Hogar. Our youth spent about 10 months raising funds and building a team to go and serve there. The ask from the Ward's and Melodie Francis at Casa Hogar was to build a

playground structure for the children at the home.

Our youth worked very hard doing work projects for people in the community, their families and our church and presented the need to our church congregation. Westney Heights Baptist Church has been very generous to our team and through hard work and lots of prayer we reached and surpassed our goal.

Our team stayed at CEE school in Siguatepeque, a Christian bilingual school. We were able to sleep and eat at the school as well as do a few work projects around their compound. We

ran a VBS for a week at CEE during the morning and one of the joys of this trip was partnering with Honduran teenagers who know English because they attend the bilingual English Spanish school as they joined with our youth to run our VBS. Having our teenagers be able to meet Honduran Christian teenagers and work together is such a blessing for our young people. One evening while we were there, Honduran Christian families invited our team into their homes for dinner and to spend an evening together. We divided up into groups of three or so, and were able to meet these Christian families in the community.

Then in the afternoons, we had three teams who would head in different directions to do building projects, painting projects both at CEE school and at Casa Hogar. Another team would head to Balibrea, a small community in the Hills outside Siguatepeque to partner with a local pastor in their work of building a church in that community.

We are so thankful for Westney Heights Baptist Church that continues to support our youth in learning about missions both at home and around the world. Each summer, we do a missions trip



to either a local ministry, an outreach to another part of Canada or a ministry overseas. (This is our 4th time going to Honduras!) It is our hope that our youth would learn that God's heart is for the whole world! We are also very grateful to Rick & Ena Ward and Melodie Francis, who were such a support in allowing us to take a team to Honduras. They were on the ground helping us navigate the complexities of a foreign culture, and we are so grateful for their support. We would recommend to any church in the Fellowship to reach out and partner with this ministry. Build a team and go and serve! It will be a wonderful blessing in the lives of your youth.

While I'm sure this was helpful for the missionaries on the ground in Honduras, the real blessing is to our young people and, what they can learn about the heart of God as well as build friendships with Christian young people in Honduras that will go with them through the rest of their lives.
