NATIONAL REQUESTS

Fellowship Chaplaincy

- Pray for the spiritual and mental health of our chaplains as they provide a ministry of presence to spiritually thirsty people wherever they live and work.
- Praise the Lord for the 159 professions of faith that were reported by Fellowship chaplains in the past 15 months. Pray that Fellowship chaplains will be sensitive to those who are seeking, and that the Lord would provide unique opportunities for them to share the love of Christ.
- The recruitment officer for the Canadian Armed Forces has encouraged us to send more Fellowship chaplains their way. Pray that more women and men from within our Fellowship churches will consider military chaplaincy as a career calling.

FAIR

- Pray that the Lord would provide personnel to fill the positions currently available at Casa Hogar (Honduras), Joy Foundation (Dominican Republic), and The Good News Hospital (Madagascar). (Visit fellowship.ca/MinistryOpportunities for more information.)
- Pray that over the next ten months the Lord would provide 400 new sponsors who are willing to invest monthly in the lives of children who are part of the Fellowship Child Sponsorship program.
- Pray for FAIR Director, Dan Shurr as he completes his ministry in March 2024; pray for our next FAIR Director, Norton Lages, as he prepares to officially begin his new role in March 2024.

Fellowship International

- Pray that the Lord would raise up individuals and churches to partner with those newly appointed Fellowship International who are seeking prayer and financial supporters for their ministry.
- Pray that Fellowship churches would embrace Fellowship International's "Catalysing Movements" strategy as unbelievers are introduced to Christ through the local church. Pray that hearts within Canada and around the world would be surrendered to Christ.

Francophone Ministry

- Pray for Steve Jones and Hugo Ethier as they meet with leaders in Fellowship churches, and as they host "Québec Vision Trips" to expose our local churches to the staggering spiritual need in Québec. With only 0.8% of Francophone Canadians self-identifying as evangelical Christians, Québec remains one of the most significantly unreached mission fields in the world.
- Pray that more individual donors and Fellowship churches will prayerfully consider joining a partnership to help establish a new church plant in Québec.

Fellowship Foundation

- Pray that more of our Fellowship family will connect with Gord Baptist (Fellowship Advance Director) to benefit from the free estate planning he offers during the preparation of their Will.
- Praise the Lord that in the first six years of the Fellowship Foundation (established March 2015), the Foundation has grown to over \$19.1 million with over \$1,000,000 in pending legacies going to our local churches.
- Pray for Fellowship churches will invite Gord Baptist and benefit from his estate planning and debt retirement workshops.
