FAIR

Director: Dan Shurr

- Pray that the Lord would raise up partners for FAIR’s **Out of the Waiting Room** special appeal in Madagascar. The goal is to raise \$145,000 which will be used over the next five years to fund the new Christian surgical training program. Fellowship missionaries **Dr. Jesh and Julie** Thiessen are involved in this ministry. With only 100 surgeons in this country of 26 million people, the need is great!
- Pray as Fellowship missionaries Diego and Claudia Cardona give leadership to the *Hands of Faith* ministry in Medellin, Colombia – a city with an estimated deaf population of 25,000. With very few resources or programs for this large population, this ministry provides unique opportunities to touch this community with the love of Christ. FAIR is currently raising \$25,000 with which to develop and provide resources to help the deaf community become disciples of Jesus.
