My wife, Maha, started the Clementia Life Centre in 2014 to educate Syrian children and this has grown from 16 to 120 children and youth. As Lebanese Evangelical churches reached out to Syrians, thousands of Muslims came to faith in Christ. The team in Beirut is reaping the fruit of this season of harvest with many church planters and disciple-makers seeing many coming to faith in Christ! In the midst of tensions in the Middle East, God is at work!"
