Location: Kyiv, Ukraine

History and Context:

This church was started in 1995 to reach those in the community who had no church background including those with higher education, young people, and children. Shortly after the Russian invasion in 2022, the church almost ceased to exist. At the first meeting after the invasion, in May 2022, only 18 people—including the pastor and worship team members—were in attendance. Since that time, God has brought about an exciting sense of renewal. Although the church is still small, they are actively ministering to different segments of the population and have 54 members.

Primary Ministries:

The church members serve those living in villages in the Kyiv and Chernihiv regions that were destroyed by the Russian invasion. They strive to extend the Kingdom of God through active service to society, especially to children, youth living on the streets, and the elderly.

Current Needs:

Funding, wisdom, and prayer for:

- The purchase of food and other essentials, as well as assistance with housing costs for the elderly and those who have lost their homes in the Kyiv and Chernihiv regions
- The repair and reconstruction of housing for those affected by the hostilities, including providing utilities like water, plumbing, and electricity
- Assistance in establishing a youth centre in the village to do evangelism work
- Providing four youth camps throughout the year
- Developing ministries to reach the street youth, elderly, and children in Kyiv
