Open Doors and Open Hearts in Lebanon

As was communicated by our missionaries serving in Lebanon, last fall was a turbulent time for people living in Lebanon. However, we have been so blessed to see the tenacity and passion of our missionaries throughout the war. Here's one story that Gladys Sebali shares with us.

"Our team visited a home where people had been displaced, and when we arrived, two girls answered the door. Their parents were not home and our team initially thought about leaving. However, the girls invited us to stay and explained that

they knew we were Christians and wanted to ask us some questions. They eagerly inquired about the differences between our religion and theirs. Seizing this opportunity, our team shared the message of Christ and His salvation with them. The girls were deeply moved, and by the end of the conversation, they asked, 'Could you bring us a Bible?' One of our team members showed them how to download the Bible app on their phones and we promised to follow up with them every week. All the time, we are hearing stories of how God is touching hearts and transforming lives even during this war."

Working with initiatives from AEBEQ (the Fellowship's Francophone Region) and other organizations like SOLA Femmes Scriptura (TGC Québec) to produce relevant, Gospel-centred resources and leadership development pathways, her goal is to raise up local leaders who can support women within their own church communities.
